POLICY

APPROVED: March 20, 1998

RE: CONSTRUCTION/INSPECTION FEE

1. Projects of less than 1,000'

Generally these will not be required to be competitively bid because they will be under \$7,500. These projects will be installed by Utility Management and Construction Company personnel (usually a combination of Ochelata personnel and Assigned personnel). The Authority will not allow projects under 1,000' to be installed by outside personnel without mitigating circumstances.

2. Projects of Greater than 1,000'

Generally construction cost on these projects will be over \$7,500. this will require a competitive bid. Customers wishing to hire a contractor directly or install the extension themselves will have this option. The authority will charge a connection fee and a price per foot for inspection.

Connection Fee:

Utility Management and Construction Company personnel must make the actual connection, time and material are included in the following fees..

Fee Schedule:

Extension Size

2"	\$1,000
3"	2,000
4"	2,000
6"	3,000

Inspection Fee: \$.25/ft. for all sizes

3. Projects not involving significant footage but costing above \$7,500 requiring competitive bids; ie Sewer Plant or Lift Stations, Water Tanks or Pump Stations. Generally these are done by the Authority but there could be a specific instance where a developer or business needs this type of installation and wants to get it done themselves. The Connection/Inspection Fee for these will be handled on a case by case basis.
